10:15-10:45	USARA PRESENTATION Cody Matheson - Recovery Coach USARA - Not treatment, they do recovery peer coaching. Coaches focus on long-term recovery Allows them to connect better with individuals Celebrate, advocate, and support people in recovery Certified Peer Support Specialists Advantage - they are trained and certified with over 40 hours of training and 100 practicum. Cody supervises other peer support specialists but is certified to treat as are some other employees (Marcey Gray) USARA does do lobbying and advocates for those in recovery (events like rally for recovery at the capital (2/20) Empower people by being person centered (person scribed) The do whatever the person needs, not just standard treatments as has been the model previously Good fit in a rural area where resources may be limited. Working with Cedar and Beaver hospital for medication assisted recovery, also works with family health care and shadow mountain detox hospital.

■ Connects with recovering addicts to discover the direction they want to go. • They also work with social detox at switchpoint. • Get calls regularly to help and are able to make a lot of connections and help significantly. • Want to create a dedicated asset in Beaver to have a local presence and have a boots on the ground here. • Can be friends with someone who is a peer support coach but can't as a treatment counselor. • Beaver has AA meetings but doesn't see as strong of results ■ AA is a little tainted in the county ■ Washington has "addict athlete" that Beaver wants to bring in. • Look at expanding USARAs reach into Duchesne, Uintah, and Beaver counties as part of the implementation grant.
